Program for 3rd-5th grade girls
8-15 girls, 3 volunteers (don't have to be female except for the head coach)-you can have multiple teams a year except the first year
10 week program, girls meet twice a week for 90 minutes
celebrate uniqueness, body image, and bullying
full curriculum
coaches are trained on teaching the curriculum
by the end of the 10 weeks girls have trained for a 5k
late March to late May
\$75 fee to participate but doesn't cover the facility rental fee
